**CALLS FOR THE V EUROPEAN PRIZE OF THE RSEQ CHEMICAL BIOLOGY DIVISION TO
YOUNG GROUP LEADERS**

The RSEQ Chemical Biology Division (*Grupo Especializado de Química Biológica*, GEQB) seeks to acknowledge and recognize outstanding young research group leaders that contribute to the field of Chemical Biology.

Regulations

1- Candidates may be researchers of any nationality who (i) develop their activity in the field of the Chemical Biology in any European country, excluding Spain, (ii) lead a research group, and (iii) have defended their Doctoral Thesis after the 31st August 2006.

2- Candidates will be endorsed by two members of the GEQB-RSEQ, who will provide a brief CV (max. 2 pages), together with a reasoned justification for the candidacy, stressing especially a published article in the past two years (or its acceptance proof) in an international research journal in which the candidate is corresponding author without the participation of his/her PhD supervisor.

3- The awardee will be elected by a Committee constituted by members of the Governing Council (*Junta de Gobierno*) of the GEQB, who will assess the merits presented by the candidates, the impact of their contributions and the relevance of the chosen article. The decision of the Committee will be definitive.

4- The prize will consist of a diploma, € 1,000, and the presentation by the Prize recipient of an invited lecture at the biennial meeting of the GEQB or at any other scientific event organized by the GEQB, including the biennial symposium of the RSEQ. Funding for the travelling costs will be provided by the GEQB.

5- Participation in the competition implies acceptance of the previous regulations.
